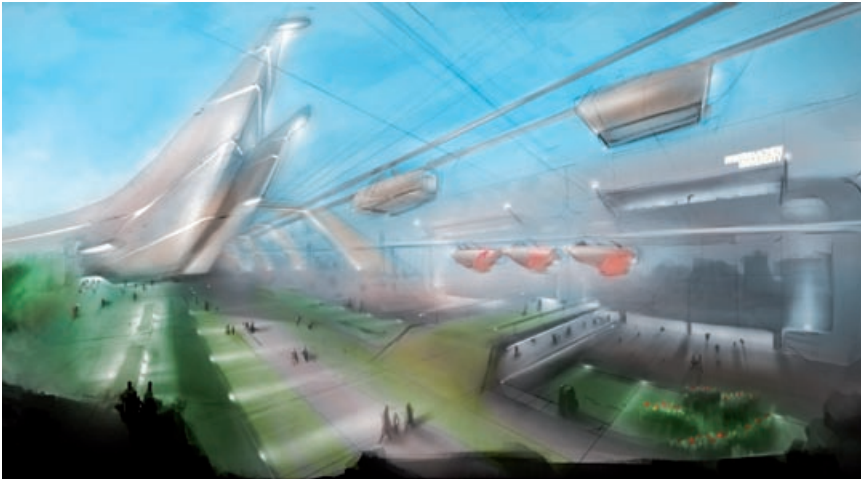

RWTH-Campusbahn Peplemover Aachen

RoCK (Regions of Connected Knowledge) is a major new European project which has secured € 5.9 million of European Regional Development Funding (ERDF) under the EU INTERREG IVB North West Europe programme. RoCK looks at ways to improve railway links between international knowledge regions and make them more user-friendly, including cross-border and international routes. It focuses on getting the most out of the existing infrastructure and developing smart solutions to improve the current transport networks. One of the RoCK projects is the RWTH-CampusBahn Aachen, an innovative tramway that connects the Aachen University campus with Aachen West train station.

This section of RoCK covers a feasibility study for a track-bound link in the planned Campus Melaten and Campus West expansion areas of the RWTH Aachen. This involves the urban design, economic and traffic specifications of a possible link between all the new and existing campus areas by means of an ultramodern, innovative public transport system. Connection of all the RWTH campus areas is planned, including access to Aachen West station (on the planned Eindhoven-Aachen IC route).
